ISLAND COUNTY VETERANS ASSISTANCE FUND

The Veterans Assistance Fund provides limited emergency assistance to eligible veterans and their dependents.



Our goal is to assist you through a temporary financial hardship. We may provide help through a voucher system, and will also help identify problem areas and provide direction to other resources that may help prevent your need for this assistance in the future.



TYPES OF ASSISTANCE

- Food
- Rental Assistance.
- Utilities with a disconnect notice.
- Medical Assistance.
- Liaison with the Veterans Administration.
- Referral to other social services.



Eligibility

- The Veteran must have honorably served on active duty for more than 180 days, for other than training purpose.
- The Veteran must have resided in Washington State for the last 12 months.
- Veterans must be indigent. To be eligible under these guidelines, the gross income of the veteran and all household members must be below 125% of the poverty guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services.

Required Documentation

- DD-214
- Discharge Certificate.
- Proof of State Residency.
- Proof of Identification.
- Marriage Certificate.
- Birth Certificates for each child.
- Lease Agreement.
- Utility Bill indicating pending disconnect.
- Award letter from the VA, DSHS, Social Security, Employment Security or Proof of wages.
